The water service meter crocks are owned and maintained by the water purveyor. Therefore, lawn irrigation systems and any other plumbing connection must be made a minimum of five (5) feet from the meter crocks.

Any connections to the domestic water service made in the meter crocks or within five (5) feet of the meter crocks, without specific written permission of the water purveyor will be rejected on inspection. Additionally, the piping will be required to be repaired to the satisfaction of the water purveyor.
