Q&A's



- Q. Do you charge a fee if there is a false alarm?
- A. There are no false alarm fees, ever!
- Q. What if no one answers the phone when the Help Dialer 700 calls?
- A. The device will call each number up to 5 times or until someone presses a key on their phone
- Q. Will I need to hire someone to install the system?
- A. No. The system will be setup by one of our deputies from the Sheriff's Office.
- Q. What if I have a stroke and cannot speak?
- A. You can record a message into the unit. When the system is activated it plays the recorded message.
- Q. How long will the panic button battery last?
- A. Since the battery is only used when a panic button is pressed the battery should last about 2 years.
- Q. If my neighbor has the same system will they interfere with each other?
- A. No. each panic button is specially coded and will not interfere with another panic button.
- Q. How would I know if the panic button battery needs to be replaced?
- A. There is a small light on the panic button that will flash red when depressed.
- Q. What happens if the power goes out?
- A. The system is AC- powered with a battery backup, so the system will not lose the programming and will operate.
