OVERVIEW

Keep Prince William Beautiful (KPWB) will provide reimbursement of landfill disposal fees for county residents using a third-party refuse hauler. In order to be eligible for reimbursement, the request must meet the following conditions:

1. *The refuse hauler must have a current, valid [Prince William County haulers permit](#).*
2. *The refuse collected must adhere to disposal requirements set forth by Prince William County Solid Waste Division, e.g., the following list of items are acceptable:*
 - a. *Household trash (items that can be recycled should follow those guidelines)*
 - b. *Yard waste*
 - c. *Scrap metal and large metal items (must be separated)*

The following list of items are not accepted and therefore not eligible for disposal reimbursement:

- a. *Batteries, electronic waste, automotive fluids, and other [household hazardous wastes](#).*
 - b. *Medical wastes*
 - c. *Tires*
 - d. *Construction and demolition debris*
 - e. *Manure*
 - f. *Large furniture*
3. *The resident/client must submit their itemized receipt ticket to KPWB for reimbursement.*



Residents seeking reimbursement should consider recycling as much waste as possible and hauling their own trash to the landfill. There are no fees for household trash except for materials such as tires, manure, pallets and other items that require special handling. KPWB will not reimburse refuse haulers for collection and transport fees.

For reimbursement all loads must be weighed in and out at the scale house. The hauler must obtain a scale ticket when weighing out and KPWB must receive a copy of that scale ticket within 30 days of transaction date. Scale tickets are itemized receipts that show the ticket number, transaction date and time, material type, weight, cost per ton, and total charge.

In addition, KPWB will only reimburse the resident or client of this contract. KPWB will not reimburse the hauler.

REFUSE AND RECYCLING COLLECTION

Prince William County does not provide trash and recycling collection, or bins for collection. Residents can haul their own trash/recycling to the Landfill, Balls Ford Compost Facility or the Saturday collection sites at Nokesville Elementary School and Evergreen Fire Station. Residents, Homeowners Associations (HOAs) and business owners may hire a private Refuse Hauler to collect trash/recycling from their homes or businesses. Refuse haulers are also listed in the yellow pages under garbage removal. The hauler charges for collection and transportation of trash. The contract is between you and private refuse hauler. The County does not regulate the fees of any refuse haulers.

Important Guidance - Household Hazardous Waste and Electronics Recycling ***Please read before coming to the landfill to dispose of items.***

The Household Hazardous Waste and Electronics Recycling program is open at the Prince William County **Landfill location only*** on Wednesdays and Saturdays from 10 a.m. to 5 pm. The program is for Prince William County residents only. This program is not available to businesses or to Manassas and Manassas Park residents.

HHW/Electronics program usage rules:

The following guidance is for the Landfill Household Hazardous Waste and Electronics program :

- All individuals should remain in their vehicles.
- This program is for Prince William residents only. IDs will be checked before entry.
- A ticket will be required for the service. Stop at the checkpoint/traffic control to get a ticket.
- Disposal is limited to three (3) electronic items; 15 gallons of liquid or 40 pounds of solid household hazardous waste items.
- Traffic flow to and around the facility may be modified due to volume, so follow staff directions.
- Vehicles will be processed until 5 p.m. (Cars in line after that time will have to come back.)

Visit www.pwcva.gov/disposalguide to confirm the type of items accepted, the quantity limits, and the preparation of items that may be brought to this program.

- ♦ Scrap metal and appliances
- ♦ Household batteries
- ♦ Clothing and shoes

Accepted at Landfill Household Hazardous Waste Program:

Hours: Wednesdays & Saturdays, 10am—5pm

- ♦ Paint, pesticides, unwanted fuel and other household chemicals
- ♦ Electronics (computers, televisions, etc.)
- ♦ Fluorescent bulbs
