There are not many expected changes, so please utilize the Southern Regionals Website (SRHC - UF/IFAS Animal Sciences - University of Florida, Institute of Food and Agricultural Sciences - UF/IFAS (ufl.edu) including 2023 schedules, rulebooks, and class lists to familiarize yourself with the show. The website also includes information about the Georgia National Fairgrounds, camping, and stalling accommodations.

Application does not guarantee acceptance/entry to Southern Regionals. Applicants will be ranked based on 2023 State Show Results. If a horse/rider combination did not participate in the 2023 Virginia State Show, they will be placed at the bottom of the list and will only be allowed to participate if there are spots open and they will be required to meet all qualifications (horsemanship skills/qualifying clinic/declaration) by the entry deadline. Acceptance lists will be posted on the VA 4-H Horse Program website no later than June 1st.

#### Opportunity for 3D Archery Event at the Virginia 4-H 2024 State Shoot



Volunteers needed! If there are enough volunteers, there will be a 3D Archery event at the 2024 State Shoot. This event is for archers with experience shooting 3D targets at unknown distances. This is not intended for beginners. Each competitor must have previously shot a score of at least 30 points out of 100 as documented on their portfolio and Portfolio Certification Document. Genesis bows are not allowed. The 3D Archery Event will consist of one (1) round of ten (10) individual 3D targets. Competitors will shoot at various distances ranging from 5-40 yards for seniors and 5-30 yards for juniors. The targets will have superimposed scoring areas that correspond to the vital areas of the animal.

This will be a squadded event on Saturday and Sunday with strictly controlled timing. Competitors need to bring enough arrows for the weekend in case of lost arrows. There will be 12 competitors on each relay, who will rotate among the firing points in a manner similar to smallbore rifle silhouette. See the attachment for details.

#### AKC Agility League for 4-H'ers

The AKC Agility League is a new AKC program that promotes training in the sport of agility. Through the league, teams compete on their home turf on courses designed by AKC-approved designers. All skill levels are offered – from international through novice. And in the Fall, there will be a new precompetition level offered for beginner dogs.

Judging is on the honor system. Captains report scores through an online system, and the AKC calculates the rankings both for teams, individual dogs and Junior Handlers who are younger than 18 years old. Special awards are given to Juniors at the end of each season.

The AKC would love to work with 4-H groups on developing teams and helping youth get involved with this fun sport. The Fall season will start in mid-September and will run for 12 weeks, ending in early December. Teams run 6 courses during the season (one new course released every two weeks).
