Prince William County held a Design Public Hearing at Chris Yung Elementary School on Monday November 18, 2019 from 6:30pm to 8:30pm for the University Boulevard Extension project. The public hearing contained a formal presentation which was directly followed up by an open forum. Additionally, citizens could walk around and view several graphics presenting the proposed improvements for the project before and after the presentation. Public hearing level plans for the project were also available. Citizens provided oral comments to a court reporter and written comments in a comment box. Citizens also sent in e-mail comments after the public hearing. Written and oral comments were accepted at the meeting and written comments were accepted after the meeting until December 6, 2019.

Representatives from Prince William County and the project team were available to speak with citizens and answer questions about this project.

### **Public Notification**

Prince William County sent a notification to nearby property owners and HOA representatives through the postal service briefly describing the project and informing them of the planned Design Public Hearing. The notification for the public hearing described above is presented in **Appendix A**. Additionally, two portable message boards were placed at the intersection of University Blvd. and Sudley Manor Dr. and at University Blvd. and Edmonston Dr. to advertise the planned Design Public Hearing to drivers passing through the project vicinity.

### **Exhibits & Documents Available at Design Public Hearing**

Information available at the public hearing included project design exhibits shown on top of an aerial imagery background, project design exhibits showing color shading of proposed improvements, graphic renderings of typical roadway cross sections, project plans, project brochures and comment sheets. The public hearing brochure and comment sheet are presented in **Appendix B**. Reduced-size reproductions of the exhibits and renderings displayed at the public hearing are presented **Appendix C**, slides from the public hearing presentation are presented in **Appendix D**, and the sign-in sheets for all public hearing attendees is included in **Appendix E**.

## **Project Background and Purpose**

This project will generally extend University Blvd. (Route 840) from Edmonston Dr. (Route 3297) to Sudley Manor Dr. (Route 1566).

The University Boulevard Extension is planned as an ultimate four-lane divided roadway, however, it will be initially designed and constructed with this project as two lanes with median curb, curb and gutter, and sidewalk on the south side of the roadway. Design includes intersection improvements at Edmonston Dr./Huddersfield Way, Lexington Valley Dr./Tappen Mill Way, and Sudley Manor Dr. To cross Dawkins Branch, a new bridge will be constructed. Single-lane roundabouts will be constructed at the University Blvd./Edmonston Dr./Huddersfield Way intersection and the University Blvd./Lexington Valley Dr./Tappen Mill Way intersection. The existing signal will be modified at Sudley Manor Dr. to accommodate the new traffic pattern west of the intersection. Existing right of way set aside for the project will be used to the extent feasible.

At the intersection of Devlin Rd. (Route 621) and University Blvd., the project is proposing an additional turn lane and a new signal. Potential improvements are under consideration at this intersection to widen a section of Devlin Rd. to a four-lane roadway with a new signal at the intersection. These improvements aim to accommodate additional capacity and improve operations on the University Boulevard Extension.

The ultimate section on University Blvd. is anticipated to consist of a four-lane divided roadway with a five-foot-wide sidewalk and a ten-foot-wide shared use path. The project also includes the coordination of private utilities and design and construction of a Service Authority waterline.

## **Summary of Comments**

Oral comments were provided by two citizens during the public hearing. Oral comments were taken by a court reporter, who then transcribed them afterwards and provided them to Prince William County. The oral comments are included in **Appendix F**. A brief summary of the oral comments is listed below.

- One comment regarding noise during construction and if there will be any proposed natural barrier following construction.
- One comment inquiring about surface water study and traffic study upon project completion.

Prince William County DOT received 22 written comments submitted by citizens either at the public hearing or afterwards. A brief summary of the written comments is listed below.

- Pedestrian safety There were several comments that expressed concern for pedestrian safety along the corridor. Many of the commenters were concerned that vehicles will frequently speed through the facility and fail to yield to pedestrians attempting to navigate crosswalks.
   Traffic signals, speed tables and stop signs were all requested for consideration.
- Abandon plans to expand to four lanes Two commenters did not want to see University Blvd. expanded to the ultimate four-lane condition sighting concerns over safety, noise and pollution.
- Shared use path Two commenters expressed a desire for the shared use path to be installed during this phase rather than with the ultimate four-lane condition to better protect bicyclists.
- Noise concerns Two commenters were worried about noise levels. One of the commenters
  was specifically concerned about noise during construction while the other was more focused
  on noise after completion.
- Further extensions to University Blvd. Two commenters wanted to hear more about the County's plans to further extend University Blvd.
- Wellington Rd. widening One commenter requested that Wellington Rd. be expanded to four lanes.
- Traffic on Edmonston Dr. One commenter was concerned about additional traffic on Edmonston Dr.
- Impacts from nearby development One commenter wanted to clarify how traffic on University Blvd. would be affected by a proposed development on the west side of Devlin Rd.
- Resurfacing of the existing roadway One commenter requested that the existing portion of University Blvd. be resurfaced.
- Construction hours One commenter was skeptical that construction would only occur during hours allowed by the noise ordinance and VDOT standards.
- Turns from side streets One commenter was concerned about the difficulty of turning on to University Blvd. from side streets, specifically mentioning turns from Hackney Dr.
- Heavy vehicle usage of the roadway One commenter requested that signage be placed to limit vehicle types that can use this portion of University Blvd.
- Construction staging areas One commenter had concerns that the staging areas could impact access to developments.
- Crosswalks on the existing portion of University Blvd. One commenter requested that additional crosswalks be installed along the existing portion of University Blvd.
- Development signage One commenter wished to clarify if funding will be provided for signage to be placed at new entrances to neighboring communities.
- Lighting One commenter requested that lighting be added to the proposed roadway.

• Trees – One commenter asked about trees in their backyard and whether they would be replanted by Prince William County.



## **PURPOSE:**

The purpose of this Design Public Hearing is to acquaint you with the project design and the features of this planned project. These meetings are beneficial to both citizens and the Prince William County Department of Transportation. They permit Prince William County Department of Transportation's (PWCDOT) engineers to report the facts developed in their studies and to obtain citizens' comments which assist in determining the design of the proposed project. Representatives from Prince William County and their design consultants are present to discuss your concerns and answer your questions. This Design Public Hearing provides the opportunity for any person (acting on their behalf or representing a group or governing body) to offer comments or submit written material concerning the proposed project. The comments you make as a result of this meeting will be considered as we further develop the design plans. We welcome your comments and suggestions, whether written or verbal.

## **DESCRIPTION:**

This project will generally extend University Boulevard (Route 840) from Edmonston Drive (Route 3297) to Sudley Manor Drive (Route 1566). The project length is approximately 2,640 linear feet. The roadway is classified by VDOT as an Urban Minor Arterial System (GS-6 Standard).












From Edmonston Drive to Sudley Manor Drive 2-Lane Road with Concrete Sidewalk







- Project length is approximately 2,640 linear feet.
- The roadway is classified by VDOT as an Urban Minor Arterial System (GS-6 Standard).
- Design speed of 50 mph, with a posted speed of 35 mph.
- With this project, University Boulevard will be constructed as a two-lane roadway with median curb, curb and gutter, and sidewalk.
- Future ultimate section for University Boulevard will be four-lane roadway with raised-grass divided median.
- Design includes adding a right turn lane and traffic signal at the intersection of Devlin Road (Route 621) and University Boulevard.
  - Potential improvements will widen Devlin Road to four lanes at this intersection.
- A single-lane roundabout will be constructed at the following two intersections:
  - University Boulevard/Edmonston Drive/Huddersfield Way
  - University Boulevard/Lexington Valley Drive/Tappen Mill Way



- Project includes signal, drainage, utility, and pedestrian access improvements.
- Existing traffic signal at Sudley Manor Drive will be modified.
- A bridge will be constructed on University Boulevard to cross Dawkins Branch.
- A single-lane roundabout will be constructed at the following two intersections:
  - University Boulevard/Edmonston Drive/Huddersfield Way



Below are comment responses for the University Boulevard Extension Project Design Public Hearing held at Chris Yung Elementary School on Monday, November 18, 2019 from 6:30pm to 8:30pm.

# **Summary of Comments**

#### Comment 1

Additional pedestrian and bicyclist safety measures should be implemented given the amount of pedestrian activity along the corridor. There are concerns that vehicles will speed through the facility and fail to yield to pedestrians attempting to navigate the crosswalks. Speed tables similar to the ones on Edmonston Dr. and traffic signals were suggested for consideration here. Concerns were also raised that vehicles are not forced to stop at the roundabouts. (13 comments)

**Response:** Mitigation measures (such as signage, pavement markings etc.) for pedestrians and bicyclists will be further evaluated as the design progresses for the University Boulevard Extension project. The proposed roundabouts at two intersections will encourage vehicles to slow down as they navigate the roundabouts. At all locations, crosswalks and other measures will be further evaluated for installation in accordance with County and VDOT policies and standards.

#### Comment 2

This portion of the roadway should remain two lanes in order to maintain a safe neighborhood and limit noise and pollution. (2 comments)

**Response**: The four-lane section is not part of the plans for the current improvement project. The current project only proposes to construct the two-lane section. Further improvements and/or alternatives for sound barriers and/or noise mitigation measures will be evaluated during the design process of the future four-lane widening project. The four-lane widening of University Blvd. is included in the Prince William County Transportation Comprehensive Plan, but is currently unfunded with no schedule for design or construction.

#### Comment 3

The shared use path should be installed during this project instead of with the expansion to 4 lanes to better protect bicyclists during the 2-lane construction. (2 comments)

**Response:** The current plan to construct the two travel lanes with a sidewalk is consistent with the existing section west of Edmonston Drive. Bicyclists will be able to use the two-lane roadway and can use the sidewalk as well if desired.

#### Comment 4

The design does not adequately address noise and privacy concerns during construction. (1 comment)

**Response**: All local noise ordinances will be followed to minimize disturbance to residents during construction. Further community outreach will be performed prior to construction.

#### Comment 5

More information should be provided regarding the final plan for extending University Blvd. beyond Devlin Rd. (2 comments).

**Response:** The County's Transportation Comprehensive Plan includes extending University Blvd. west to connect to US Route 29 in the future.

#### Comment 6

Wellington Rd. should be expanded to four lanes. (1 comment)

**Response:** Comment noted. The widening of Wellington Rd. is beyond the scope of the University Boulevard Extension project.

#### Comment 7

Concern about additional traffic on Edmonston Dr. (1 comment)

**Response:** Vehicular traffic on Edmonston Dr. is projected to decrease based on preliminary traffic study results. This is largely due to the elimination of the need to utilize Edmonston Dr. as a cut-through to continue along University Blvd. or access Sudley Manor Dr.

#### Comment 8

The proposed development on the west side of Devlin Rd. may cause traffic along the roadway to increase beyond what traffic is currently being designed for. (1 comment)

**Response:** Approved developments were considered in the development of the projected traffic volumes for the preliminary traffic report, consistent with the County's overall traffic forecasting model.

#### Comment 9

The existing roadway along University Blvd. needs repair and should be resurfaced. Additional construction traffic will likely increase the need for repairs. (1 comment)

**Response:** No maintenance improvements are planned on the existing portions of University Blvd. Please see the VDOT Maintenance and Road Problem website for more information on requesting maintenance on existing roads (https://my.vdot.virginia.gov/).

#### Comment 10

Concerns that construction will extend beyond the allowed time periods. (1 comment)

**Response:** Construction impacting traffic along existing roadways will be strictly limited to hours permitted by VDOT. Construction outside normal working hours will be required to adhere to County noise ordinances.

#### Comment 11

Concern that the additional traffic along University Blvd. will make turns from side streets (specifically Hackney Dr.) very difficult. (1 comment)

**Response:** At this time, no additional improvements at these intersections are planned.

#### Comment 12

Concern about the impact of heavy trucks utilizing the roadway. Signage should be implemented to limit what vehicles may use the roadway. (1 comment)

**Response:** Currently there are no plans to restrict truck traffic on University Blvd. VDOT has a specific process and requirements that must be met to implement a truck restriction. Given its roadway classification, University Blvd would most likely not qualify for a truck restriction.

#### Comment 13

Entry and exit into the Abberly Avera apartment complex could be impacted if the entryway is used as a construction staging area. (1 comment)

**Response:** Prior to construction, the County will review all staging areas and truck routes with the Contractor to ensure impacts to local neighborhoods is minimized.

#### Comment 14

Will there be any funding given to the Independence community to install new signage for the new entrances into the community? (1 comment)

**Response:** Additional signage for adjacent communities is not planned as part of this project, and is the responsibility of the private owner/community.

#### Comment 15

There needs to be lighting along the length of the new addition. (1 comment)

**Response:** Lighting for the project is currently being evaluated.

#### Comment 16

Sound barriers and/or wall should be placed between the road and homes. (1 comment)

**Response:** The current design for a two-lane University Blvd. does not include a sound barrier or noise wall. With the future four-lane roadway, the possibility of building a sound barrier along University Boulevard to alleviate noise from traffic will be considered.

#### Comment 17

Citizen had concerns with noise during construction and if there will be any proposed natural barrier following construction.

**Response:** As stated previously in Comment Response #4, all local noise ordinances will be followed to minimize disturbance to residents during construction. Additionally, the current design is not proposing any natural barriers for the two-lane University Blvd. With the future four-lane roadway, the possibility of proposing a natural barrier along University Blvd. to alleviate noise from traffic will be considered.

#### Comment 18

Citizen asked if a surface water study had been completed and incorporated in the design and would like to see the traffic study for University Blvd. two-lane design upon project completion.

**Response:** Drainage was considered as a part of our design process for University Blvd., which includes the analysis of stormwater quality and quantity. For any document requests, please contact Prince William County Department of Transportation.

#### Comment 19

Citizen asked about trees that would be impacted by the University Boulevard Extension Project behind their property (8801 Worsley Ct., Bristow VA) and their neighbor's (8800 Worsley Ct., Bristow VA). In addition, citizen asked if the County will be considering a private fence for these properties. Finally, the citizen would like to know how much of their property will be acquired for right-of-way and how much they would be compensated.

**Response:** As a part of this project, trees will be removed as necessary to construct the project. The current design for a two-lane University Boulevard does not propose fences for properties along University Boulevard. During the Right of Way Acquisition Phase, affected properties will be notified by Prince William County about right-of-way and easement needs and proposed compensation.
