

BUILDING OFFICIAL INTERPRETATION 2018-01 July 01, 2021

CODE/EDITION: VIRGINIA UNIFORM STATEWIDE BUILDING CODE/2018

SECTION(S): Section 108.0 Application for Permit

QUESTION:

- 1. Is a Construction Permit required when mechanical equipment (i.e. roof top unit, air handling unit, hot water heater) is being repaired and individual parts of that mechanical equipment must be replaced?
- 2. Is a Construction Permit required when the entire mechanical unit is being replaced?
- 3. Is a Construction Permit required when a mechanical fire damper is being replaced with an identical fire damper?

ANSWER:

- 1. No. Based on Section 108.1 When Permit is Required, the replacement of an individual part with the exact same part within an existing mechanical unit is considered an ordinary repair.
- 2. Yes, if the mechanical equipment is fueled by gas or oil.

No, if the mechanical equipment is not fueled by gas or oil and is in a Use Group R-2 where serving a Single Family Dwelling and Use Group R-3, R-4, and R-5.

Yes, if the mechanical equipment is in any other Use Groups.

3. Yes. If a replacement part is associated with a building's life safety system (i.e. sprinkler system, fire alarm system, smoke evacuation, mechanical fire dampers), then the work is not an ordinary repair, and a permit is required.
