AMENDMENT TO MANDATORY FACE COVERING ORDER OF MAY 20, 2020

Based on discussions with the Prince William County Health Department and per the Centers for Disease Control Guidelines, the courthouse mask directive is amended as follows:

Effective March 7, 2022, individuals entering the Prince William County Judicial Center are not required to wear masks. Mask requirements in courtrooms are at the discretion of the presiding judge.

The Court encourages all visitors to protect their health and the health of others. While face coverings are no longer required, we will continue to support individuals who choose to continue wearing them.
