Approve Minutes

CSA Division Report - presented by Jessica Webb

- JARC Annual Review The JARC met in August to review all group home referrals during the previous 12 months. The Committee has recommended that the CPMT consider asking the BoCS to dissolve the resolution that requires JARC, based on the following:
 - o When JARC was formed, there were multiple group homes within the County. We now only have one boys group home (Turning Point Home for Boys) and one girls group home (YFT).
 - o The utilization of group home placements is considerably lower now than when JARC was initially formed. We averaged less than 1 per month in the past year.
 - There are state regulations that require that proximity to community be considered when considering any residential placement, and that requirement is reviewed during regular CSA audits.
 - The landscape of residential care is changing, to emphasize Qualified Residential Treatment Providers in addition to level of care (group home or psychiatric residential treatment facility).

- o The internal controls within the CSA program, coupled with enhanced FAPT member training, has resulted in closer monitoring internally of all requirements related to residential care placements.
- o The annual reviews, while not time consuming, do not continue to have a value-added component. There are other measures in place that ensure we are following the appropriate process for placements.

The two group home providers have been consulted about this request, and both will need to support the action of dissolving the JARC.

"Tell Me Something Good" - The CSA Division annual customer satisfaction survey came back with the majority of respondents choosing "very satisfied." Congratulations to the CSA team for continuing to do great work!
