## COUNTY OF PRINCE WILLIAM COURTHOUSE PROTOCOLS

Effective immediately, all persons entering the Prince William Courthouse must comply with the following protocols.

Entering the Courthouse: All persons entering the building are encouraged to conduct a temperature self-screening at the building entrance. Anyone with a temperature of 100.4 degrees or higher will be denied entry into the building.

By entering the building, all persons certify that:

- They do not have symptoms of COVID-19; which include temperature of 100.4 degrees or more, chills, cough, difficulty breathing, unusual fatigue, muscle or body aches, headache, new loss of taste or smell, sore throat, congestion, nausea, vomiting, or diarrhea.
- They are not subject to isolation under CDC (Centers for Disease Control and Prevention) guidelines following a diagnosis of COVID-19 or probable COVID-19.
