Commercial Applicators

- Applying pesticides for a fee
- Government Employee applying for work related tasks
- Registered Technicians operate under the supervision of a commercial applicator when applying pesticides for a fee

Commercial Category 6: Right of Way

 Applying pesticides in rights of way (i.e. along streets, sidewalks, power lines, railroads, etc.)

Commercial Category 3A: Ornamentals

 Applying pesticides in ornamental landscapes to trees, shrubs and flowers for a job or for hire.

Commercial Category 3B: Turf

 Applying pesticides in turf, sports turf and lawns as part of a job or for hire.

Private Applicators

 Use restricted use pesticides on their own property, property they lease, or owner by their employer (i.e. farmer)
